

Curriculum vitae of Prof. Giovanni Bomboi A.A. 2018-2019

Prof. Giovanni Bomboi graduated in Veterinary Medicine at the University of Sassari in 1982. He worked as a Researcher on the Physiology of Domestic Animals from 1983 and confirmed researcher from 1987 until 1997 at the same University. In 1998, he became Associate Professor specialized on the Physiology of Animal Nutrition and confirmed Professor in 2001 at the Department of Animal Biology merged into the Department of Veterinary Medicine of the University of Sassari.

He currently teaches the following courses Physiology of animal nutrition in the Department of Veterinary Medicine and Veterinary Anatomy and Physiology at the Department of Agriculture of University of Sassari. He also taught the following courses: Cellular Physiology, Propaedeutics of Biochemistry (Organic Chemistry), Veterinary Biochemistry and Biochemical and Chemical Veterinary Methodologies.
